Welcome to Hamersley Rovers Junior FC. This information is designed to provide you with key information about the club, competitions, guide to registering as well as information about activities and events coming up in the near future.

2012 REGISTRATION PROCESS

Returning Players

Players returning from last year have priority on available places until **January 31st 2012**. Returning players must return their **completed club registration form to the Club by January 31st 2012** and **payment** to the club should be **finalized by February 11th 2012**. After this time returning players will NO LONGER have registration priority and places in teams will be made available to all registrations including new players.

PARENT / VOLUNTEER HELP

Match Day

Throughout the season each team will need the support and assistance of parents in a variety of ways including acting as Match Day Officials, First Aid, putting up and packing away nets at home games, refereeing matches where no official referees are appointed, linesman duties, assisting at training sessions. **Your children cannot play unless we have help with these tasks.** Training and information about these tasks including referee and linesman duties can be provided.

Club Management - Committee

The club relies on the support of parents and other volunteers in various roles including being part of the committee and helping with the organization and running of **YOUR** club. Participating on the committee is not difficult but we do need more people to take on an active role in the running of the club. Committee roles and tasks are outlined at the end of this document – please read this and nominate a role or task on your registration form.

ALLOCATION OF PLAYERS TO TEAMS

Every season we have to balance the needs of players, teams and the club in allocating players to teams and the committee reviewed and discussed this issue on a number of

occasions during 2010 and 2011. In the interests of best meeting the needs of players, teams and the club, in 2012 players will be allocated to teams in accordance with our Team Team Selection Policy (see [Team Selection Policy](#))

REFEREES & REFEREE FEES

Small Sided Football Competition (SSF) 5/6-11s

Games are run by Team Coordinators and Game Leaders following modified rules – official referees are not used and no referee fees are paid.

Junior, Girls Only & Youth Teams – 12s to 18s

- Official referees may be appointed to matches and payment will be required. This applies to both home and away matches.
- Where no official referee is appointed, the Home Team is required to supply a volunteer referee to officiate the match (no payment).
- Referee Fees are included with individual registration fees. The Club will distribute these funds to team Managers to cover the cost of official referees. Any funds remaining at the end of the season may be used by the team or reimbursed to players as agreed by the team members.

INFORMATION ABOUT TEAM AGE GROUPS

Note 1: Age group is your child's age at 31st December 2012 (not based on the school year ages)

Small Sided Football Competition (SSF) – 5/6-11s (includes Girls Only 11s if available)

SSF is a modified version of the game designed to meet the needs of player's aged 5-11. These are fun games that encourage players to have **more touches** of the ball, **more shots** on goal, **more 1 v 1 attacking** situations with the emphasis on player development and easy to understand games. Clubs, coaches, team supervisors and parents play the most important role in reinforcing the SSF emphasis on participation and enjoyment of the game. Players are eligible to play in the SSF 5/6s age group if they turn 5 or 6 in 2012.

- ⚽ Ages 5/6 and 7yrs play in a club hub format with 2-3 other local clubs and will play for several weeks at each clubs venue.
- ⚽ Ages 8s to 11s play in a home and away format with games played in the North Western Zone competition.

Junior Competition (Mixed 12s-16s and Girls Only 13s, 14s & 15s)

Teams aged 12 to 16 - matches played on a full sized pitch with 11 players plus 3 interchangeable substitutes per team. Games are played in a home and away format across the Metropolitan area or in the North Zone competition depending upon the league placements. Official Referees are used and FFA match rules apply, (with some minor amendments).

Youth Competition (Mixed 17/18s and Girls Only 17s)

Players aged 17-18 - matches played on a full sized pitch with 11 players plus up to 5 interchangeable substitutes per team. Games are played in a home and away format across the Metropolitan area. Official Referees are used and FFA match rules apply, (with some minor amendments).
